



Triangle

**E. GENERAL TIPS FOR FUTURE TIE DYE PROJECTS**

1. After you have learnt the basic techniques, you can start dyeing other projects, such as T-Shirts, with the remaining dye solution.
2. Always pre-wash your fabric. This will remove stiffness from new fabric and prevent shrinkage after the first wash.
3. Dye works better on natural materials, like cotton, linen, wool, silk, hemp, rayon etc. It works best on 100% cotton fabrics.
4. Do not place "opposite colours" next to each other, such as magenta next to green or yellow next to purple. The blending of the colours will look muddy.
5. When you are making the classic spiral pattern, lay the fabric flat on the table. Twist and coil around the centre. Make sure the pleats are small and consistent. Your work will look better the more pleats there are.
6. Sometimes the dye will stain your skin even when you wear gloves. This is normal and the colour stain will vanish in a few days with repeated washing.
7. Prepare an equal proportion of white vinegar and cold water. After you rinse the dye fabric, soak in the vinegar solution for 30 minutes. The vinegar solution will further fix the colour.



**A. SAFETY MESSAGES FOR SUPERVISING ADULTS**

1. Please read through all the instructions and keep them since it contains important information.
2. This kit is intended for children over 8 years of age, preferably with adult supervision and assistance.
3. Make sure that all dye solution containers are securely closed and properly stored after use. Store in a safe place. Keep out of reach of small children.
4. Do not inhale the dye powder. Do not allow any dye powder or solutions to come into contact with the eyes, mouth or other part of the body.
5. The dyes provided are intense colours. Always wear a pair of glove and wash hands with soap thoroughly after use. While any stains on skin would be temporary, it may take a few days to be completely removed. You are advised to wear a plastic apron to protect your clothings from the stains too.
6. Take care not to spill any solution or dye powder. They may leave permanent stains on clothing or surfaces e.g. wooded table. Cover your work area with a plastic table sheet. The working area should be cleaned immediately after carrying out the activity.
7. Dye may leave stains on the some bath tubs or washing sinks. Drain away the residue solution or rinsing water into toilet with flushing water.
8. Do not wash your dyed fabric with other laundry as they may stain. Always wash separately.
9. The gloves provided are not intended for medical use and should not be used to substitute personal protective equipment gloves.


**B. CONTENTS**

Part A: bottles with coloured dye x 5 (yellow, red, blue, green and purple), Part B: drainage tray x 1, Part C: towels x 4, Part D: 1 pair of gloves, Part E: rubber bands x 20. Also required but not included in this kit: scissors, paper towels, plastic bags (or zip bags) and water.




Remarks to prevent staining: Tie Dye is a method of dyeing fabric. It is a fun technique that involves knotting the fabric using rubber bands or string and immersing it in the dye solution to make beautiful patterns. Before you start, protect the work surface with plastic sheeting, then cover it with an additional layer of paper towels which serve to absorb the spilled dye. Prepare some wet paper towels too, as you may need them to remove stains from spills on your work surface or your gloves. Wear gloves throughout the entire dye mixing process. You may use cleaning gloves from home for better protection. Wear an apron to protect your clothing from stains. As a general practice, please clean the gloves after you handle one colour and before you start the next. Remove any colour stains with a piece of damp tissue. This will prevent the residue dye from staining the white towels or the new colours.

### C. INSTRUCTIONS



1. Mixing the dye solution: Open the bottle cap, carefully fill the dye bottle with water to the level indicated. Replace the cap tightly. Shake gently until the dye inside is dissolved. Mixed dye solution will start to lose its colour with time and will result in weaker colour intensity. Always carry out the dyeing process when the dye is freshly mixed, ideally within a day.
2. Preparing the fabric: You could start by dyeing any fabric you like, e.g a T-shirt, a cotton bag etc. If you are new to tie dye, you could use the towels included for experimenting with different dye techniques. Soak the towels into water, squeeze and remove excess water and leave damp. This will facilitate the dye colour dispersion.
3. Tying the fabric: Different tying techniques will determine the final dye patterns. Select a pattern from the following section. Follow the steps for folding. Tie with the rubber bands provided or string from home.
4. Dyeing the fabric: Place your tied fabric on the drainage tray. The pattern of strips will drain away the excess dye. Squeeze the dye solution bottle and apply it onto the fabric. Make sure the dye has penetrated all the way through. Do not apply excess dye. Do not apply different colour dyes close to each other, the resulting colours may become muddy. Apply the colours one at a time.
5. Setting the colours: Make sure all excess dye has drained on the tray. Carefully put the dyed fabric into a plastic bag or zip bag. Close the bag to keep it damp. Let it set for 6-8 hours or longer for more intense colours.
6. Rinsing the dyed fabric: Take the dyed fabric out of the plastic bag and put it in a plastic bucket. (Use a plastic bucket as the dye may stain your sink or bathtub). Remove the rubber bands. Rinse with water until the excess dye is removed. Do not use fabric softener. Continue rinsing until the water is clear. Flush the dye water down the toilet. Hang and dry the fabric as usual. Your tie dye art is completed. You may iron and mount it in a frame as a room decoration.
